Day 1 - Mitchell River Falls

0630 Kingfisher will collect you from your local accommodation

0700 Depart Kununurra Airport for a $1^1/2$ hr private aircraft flight to Mitchell Plateau. Enroute, view the Ord River Diversion Dam and irrigated farmlands, and the spectacular Cockburn Ranges. Subject to bookings, we may land at El Questro and welcome other guests to the flight. Your journey continues across the vast expanse of the rarely visited Central Kimberley.

0830 We arrive at the natural bauxite rich airfield at Mitchell Plateau to be greeted by your APT hosts and guide. Once settled iat the Lodge, enjoy a bush breakfast before heading out by 4WD and guided walk to the majestic Mitchell Falls.



Relax at the Falls and enjoy a picnic lunch before boarding a helicopter for your flight back to the ranger station, and return to the Lodge by 4WD. Take the opportunity to explore and enjoy the unique flora or swim at the campsite in the dappled afternoon sunlight. After dinner, enjoy the quiet and convivial atmosphere of this very isolated retreat, before retiring to your comfortable tented accommodation.

Day 2 / 3 / 4 - Kimberley Coastal Camp

Your journey continues across the vast expanse of the rarely visited Central Kimberley.

After an unhurried breakfast, travel by 4WD to Walsh Point at the Admiralty Gulf and then short cruise to the very remote Kimberley Coastal Camp.

There is no place like the Kimberley Coastal Camp, and there is no other place further from where you have come.

Your time at the camp is yours to plan at your leisure. The atmosphere is relaxed and unpretentious, with no pre-set itineraries. You set your own pace with the always helpful guidance of your hosts, Tub and Julie.

Spend your time mud crabbing, fishing for Barramundi or any of dozens of other species in the pristine azure waters. Or simply explore on foot or by boat an ancient land and experience the local wildlife, bush tucker, and medicines first hand.

Discover remarkable Wandjina and Gwion Gwion (Bradshaw) rock art which has been part of this land-scape and the lives of its traditional owners for thousands of years.

Or you may prefer to leisurely cruise and picnic on boab tree fringed deserted islands, or simply relax on a day bed with a cold drink under a cloudless Kimberley sky. The choices are entirely yours.

Passionate, interested, knowledgeable guides and hosts will ensure your stay at Kimberley Coastal Camp is a memorable one.







Day 5 - Kalumburu and the Timor Sea Coast

Transfer by boat to Walsh Point and 4WD to the Mitchell Plateau airfield

0900 Depart Mitchell Plateau and re-join Kingfisher's Wandjina Explorer flight to the coast and to your next adventure. Enroute you will view the rich pearl farms of Vansittart Bay, the WWII Truscott airbase, and mile upon mile of pristine coast.

1000 Arrive at the remote aboriginal settlement of Kalumburu for a tour of the Catholic Mission, its unique Church and its fascinating museum, the Community Art Centre and the historic WWII aircraft graveyard. The locals are welcoming of visitors and often stop for a chat. A delicious picnic brunch is served on the Mission lawns.



1230 Depart Kalumburu for the remote Timor Sea coast, overflying the mouth of the Drysdale River, Faraway Bay, King George Falls, Berkeley River, and the mighty Cambridge Gulf. At the Ord River delta we track east following its meandering path and tidal floodplain rich in migrating birdlife and saltwater crocodiles basking in the midday sun. We pass by House Roof Hill, the backdrop to Baz Luhman's "Australia" movie. The Ord River Irrigation Area and its expanding farmlands are then revealed as we set our final course for the oasis town of Kununurra.

1430 Arrive Kununurra and transfer to accommodation.
